NOTES [1] The only aspect of this case that may be new law is in regard to the lawfulness of the officers' conduct. As to that aspect, the parties agree that the law is settled, so we need not consider whether the new law applies. The only issue in regard to the lawfulness of the conduct is whether the officers violated our constitutionally protected privacy right to refuse medical treatment. That right, which is protected by the Fourth Amendment, *Schmerber v. California*, 384 U.S. 757, 771-72, 86 S.Ct. 1826, 16 L.Ed.2d 908 (1966), requires only a reasonable person standard. See *Villanueva v. City of Albuquerque*, 371 F.3d 1206, 1215 (10th Cir.2004) ("It is not the role of the courts to determine the permissibility of certain intrusions into the body, only to determine whether reasonable intrusion took place." (quotation omitted)); *Henry v. Anderson*, 361 F.3d 1242, 1247 (10th Cir.2004) ("The federal constitution does not protect a party from being subjected to medical procedures he or she consents to."). [2] It is also relevant to the protection of the privacy right that the person with the right and it is the suspect, not the interrogator initiates an interrogation. See *United States v. Rohrig*, 98 F.3d 1506, 1520 (6th Cir.1996) ("The suspect must first initiate the encounter in a noncoercive manner, for `a person may not be detained against his will simply because a police officer believes he may have information about a crime.'"
